What level of service do we want to provide? Do we want stations down in the bay or up by Highway 95?

APPARATUS

- Engines 421, 422, 423, 426 We use 2 of these
- Transition to type 3 engines
- We really need 3 type 3's, 3 tenders and 3 brush trucks
- Do we need as many vehicles as we have?

Are fleet is aging and needs to be updated. We need to surplus our older vehicles. Reduce apparatus in our fleet by year 5.

INFRASTRUCTURE

- Are the Bay Stations in good locations?
- Should our stations be closer to Highway 95?
- Station 2 Keep, Sell, Tear down.
- Sell the Bay Stations and build a new station where station 2 is.

Our current stations should have the following vehicles in them:

Station 1 - Type 1 Engine, Brush Truck, 2 – Tenders, Ambulance, Rescue, U499

Station 2 - Type 3 Engine, Tender

Station 3 - Type 1 Engine, Brush Truck

Station 5 - Type 3 Engine, Tender

Station 6 - Type 3 Engine, Tender, Boat, Squirt

Maintenance - Lube, Oil and Filters

- Research contract for maintenance, possible Worley Highway
- We need to have a solution for maintenance by year 3
